

Indoor Campfire

No indoor tent is complete without an indoor campfire. Follow the instructions below to build your own fire-less fire.

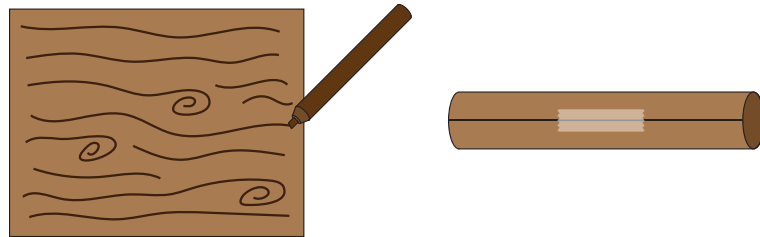
MATERIALS

- brown or black marker
- brown construction paper, 5 to 8 pieces
- tape, double or single-sided
- red, orange and yellow tissue paper
- long sticks
- white cotton batting

STEP 1: LOGS

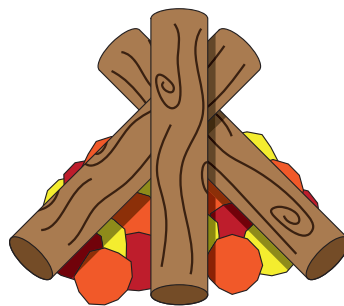
Use the marker to draw long, wavy lines on the construction paper. Make sure you draw them parallel to the long side of the paper, not the short side. Add knots, by drawing circular swirls.

After you've drawn a log texture on every piece of construction paper, roll each one up, starting with the long edge, and use tape to hold them together.



STEP 2: CAMPFIRE

Crumple up the tissue paper and put it in a pile to create your fire. Lay your paper logs on top, like a tee-pee. Your campfire is ready to go!



STEP 3: ROASTING MARSHMALLOWS

Go outside and collect a few long sticks, one for each member of your family. Once you've collected enough, use a handful of cotton batting to make a fluffy fake marshmallow, and stick one on the end of each stick.
