## ACCESSIBILITY FOR ONTARIANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT, 2005 2013 Multi-Year Accessibility Plan

INTRODUCTION: In 2005, the Ontario Government passed the Accessibility for Ontarian with Disabilities Act (AODA), which requires that Ontario be an accessible province by 2025. It has introduced a phased-in approach to the implementation of requirements through regulations under AODA. To help public, private and not-for profit organizations identify, prevent and remove barriers to accessibility, the AODA sets out specific accessibility standards in five areas; Customer Service, Information and Communications, Employment, Transportation, and the Built Environment (which is still in draft form). This Five-year Accessibility Plan builds on past planning and consultation. The Great Wolf Lodge Niagara Falls (Ripley's Water park resort LP) will continue to build on and develop operational polices and guidelines for pack members as outlined in this plan. It is a living document that outlines our goals and objectives. This plan shall be posted on our website and will be made available in alternate formats on request.

OUR COMMITMENT: Great Wolf Lodge (Ripley's Niagara Water Park Resort LP) is committed to treating all people in a way that allows them to maintain their dignity and independence. We believe integration and equal opportunity and are committed to meeting the needs of people with disabilities in a timely manner. We will do so by preventing and removing barriers to accessibility and meeting accessibility requirements under the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act ("AODA").
